

  - US Agency for International Development (USAID)





- Afghan National Army increasing.
- Major Infrastructure investments for longterm stability.
- International Security Afghanistan Forces (NATO, or "ISAF").
- US and other Military presence.

# **TAP:Mines**

All major highway routes de-mined.

Proposed pipeline route is NOT located in heavily mined areas.

 Regional leaders coordinating with national redevelopment plans.





 Afghanistan maintains 5 experienced demining organizations.

 Minister of Mines and Industries presently chairs Afghanistan's National De-Mining Committee.

# TAP: Rights of Way:



- Most of the proposed route passes through low population density areas.
- Government of Afghanistan has right of eminent domain.
- Securing rights of way is NOT difficult.



#### **TAP: Enabling Environment**



- Draft hydrocarbon law prepared.
- Gas regulatory body being established.
- Environmental protocols under development.
- No significant problems with relocation issues.

#### Afghanistan: A Good Neighbor



- Afghanistan is building regional relationships to promote trade.
  - ECO
  - SARC
  - Shanghi 5
- Afghanistan will issue multiple-entry visas to support pipeline works.
- Simple administrative requirements will NOT stop TAP.





- Is a transit country for TAP.
- Is not a producer or principal consumer of gas to/from TAP.
- Seeks to enhance regional trade cooperation.
- Will collaborate with TAP partners.
